



The Common Ground Collective is based in Algiers. We are comprised of local and outside volunteers. Our lives are dedicated to working toward social justice for all peoples. We see that there was great inequality before the storm in the ninth ward. We believe this inequality continued during the storm, and we see that this inequality is continuing NOW, after the storm.

Since Katrina hit, our collective has built a community center in Algiers that offers water, food, cleaning supplies, internet access, house repairs and a free medical clinic. We are a community-run organization offering solidarity and mutual aid to the citizens of New Orleans and the surrounding areas. Common Ground's team includes doctors, lawyers, aid workers, community organizers, and volunteers of all stripes and creeds.

This is a determining time for residents of the Ninth Ward. It is critical that the residents return home. Common Ground will aid local efforts in the creation of similar services and share a common vision of deaning up and rebuilding the Ninth Ward.
